The BARRON COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY was established in 1960 with a purpose to preserve, advance, and disseminate knowledge of the history of Barron County. Numerous programs have evolved within the society, such as the Junior Historical Contest for 4th grade students and school tours each spring at Pioneer Village Museum and the Museum, by its very nature is the most visible, and benefits the entire community and surrounding area.

Each year we try to add new displays and sometimes a building. For example, the new Marine Building that was built last year, which will be home for the 1920 Stout Launch, which is being restored by some of the volunteers. This project involves much effort, time, and money.

The Society operates Pioneer Village Museum almost entirely by volunteer effort and our budget depends on membership fees, donations and gifts that support programming, funds museum displays and exhibits and pays operating costs.

Pioneer Village Museum is open Thursday through Sunday, regular hours from 1-5 p.m. every week from June through Labor Day with many special events scheduled for weekends during the season.

Participation as a voting member of the society and all members are encouraged to attend both the spring and fall annual membership meetings where we look at the business of the society and gather for good food, fun and fellowship.
